

Welcome to the Jasper County American Rescue Plan Act Online Application!

November 2, 2022

The information below explains how a portion of Jasper County's State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds may be used.

County officials have made a commitment to be good stewards of the ARPA funds and to utilize these funds in a strategic manner that best serves all of Jasper County. As such, County officials continue to work diligently gathering data and information regarding community needs, evaluating feasibility of multiple priorities, and getting accurate cost estimates to meet these community needs. Until this process is complete, the County is unable to obligate a set dollar amount to be distributed into the community in the form of grant funds, or to provide a timeline of when the projects and grant awards will be made.

Funding Overview

Application will be accepted on a rolling basis. While the County continues its efforts to narrow the community's needs and feasibility, funding decisions may not be made.

Funding will be limited to \$50,000 per entity. There will be no funding provided to individuals.

Applicants may be subject to additional monitoring.

Projects that serve all of Jasper County will receive priority.

Applications related to loss of revenue and premium pay are not being accepted at this time.

No reimbursements will be made. Approval is for future projects only. Projects must be completed by December 31, 2024.

Eligibility

Other eligibility requirements are:

- Entities must be registered with SAM.gov.
- Entity must be located in and/or serve beneficiaries in Jasper County.
- Projects and expenses must be allowable by the Treasury.

Application Process

Only Online Applications will be accepted. The process will be as follows:

- Follow the application link – <https://www.jasperarpa.com/s/>.
- Complete the application (it will take approximately 20 – 30 minutes).
- The Application is saved once you click “Submit” at the end.
- IMPORTANT! Have your information ready & accessible prior to starting the application process as you will need to complete and submit the application in one sitting.
- Upon submission, you will receive a confirmation e-mail.
- Complete applications that pass all compliance checks will be presented to the Jasper County Commission for final decision.
