Jasper County Right of Way Management Policy UTILITY WORK PERMITS

Adopted May 5, 2005

Utility Work Permit - A permit issued to Utility Companies and the general public for all work within Jasper County Right of Way. A Utility Work Permit shall be required for all utilities that plan to work within County Maintained Right of Way. The following terms shall be met.

Terms:

1. Construction plans shall be submitted and approved before Jasper County will issue a Utility Work Permit. (A sketch of the proposed work may be allowed for small projects)

3. Enter into a Utility Work Permit Agreement with Jasper County.

Jasper County reserves the right to require a deposit or surety bond for work on Jasper County Right of Way.

- 4. Applicant shall submit a schedule for work to be completed for the Utility Work Permit. The list shall include the location, explanation of work, and the dates when work is scheduled.
- 5. The Applicant shall contact the Jasper County Highway Department Road Superintendent or the Special Road District Representative before starting construction and after completion. (See Exhibit C for contact information)
- 6. All Asphalt and Chip and Seal Roads must be bored. (See Encasement Pipe and Bore Detail for more information, Exhibit A) The Jasper County Commission reserves the right to allow open cut crossing for special circumstances.
- 7. Open cuts when permitted by the County Commission will be repaired according to the Pavement Repair Details (See Exhibit B)

- 8. Utilities must be constructed parallel with the roadway. Road crossing must be constructed at right angles to the roadway where possible.
- 9. Minimum cover for new underground utilities shall be: Forty-two inches (42") for all water lines (parallel and crossing); forty-two inches (42") for fiber optic cable (crossings); thirty inches (30") for direct burial and in trench fiber optic cable (parallel); twenty-four inches (24") for all other direct burial cable (parallel); and thirty inches (30") for all other underground utilities (parallel and crossing).
- 10. Underground Utilities must be placed a minimum of 2' behind the flow line of ditches and within 6 feet of the Right of way line.

In areas where there are no ditches the underground utility must be placed a minimum of 4' from the edge of the roadway and within 6 feet of the Right of way line.

All above ground utilities shall be within 2' of the Right of Way line.

- 11. Any road closures must be pre-approved and a minimum or 48 hours shall be allowed for public notice. The utility company or utility permit applicant shall be required to notify emergency 911 before closing roads.
- 12. All disturbed soils shall be raked smooth, 2" or large rocks shall be removed, seeded with grass, and then mulched to limit erosion. In area where a yard is disturbed the contractor shall restore the yard to its original condition.
- 13. Motorist must be protected by standards of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
- 14. The contractor shall clean up every day before proceeding with additional work.
- 15. A copy of the Permit must be at the construction site during all utility construction.
- Any person who violates any requirements or provisions of these regulations shall 16. be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor pursuant to 229.370 RSMo. and punished therefore as prescribed by law. Any person who violates any requirement or provision of these regulations may, in addition to any criminal liability thereof, be civilly liable to the County by way of restitution for such sums and costs the County incurs in repairing or restoring any right of way under utility permit or otherwise if the County gives notice of violation to the permitee by personal delivery or regular mail and a specified time to cure. Such notice shall advise the permitee of the deficiencies in work and violations of regulations hereunder and advise the permitee that the permitee shall be required to make appropriate restoration or repair within the time stated in the notice and such permitee shall be required to guarantee all such work for (12) twelve months after restoration or repair is made. In the event the permitee fails to perform the work required by the notice within the time specified by the notice, or fails to guarantee the work after it is performed, then the County may perform or cause to be performed all remedial measures and charge the expense thereof to the permitee which expense

shall be chargeable against any bond or cash deposit made by the permitee, or may be recoverable by action filed in the Circuit Court of Jasper County, Missouri, for restitution for all such expenses so incurred as well as the cost of enforcement.

- 17. Any person who fails to obtain a permit for utility work within Jasper County Right of Way will be subject to a fine of up to \$500.
- 18. There shall be a minimum of \$100,000 combined single limit of bodily injury and property damage coverage in a general liability policy as well as commercial auto policy.






